Notes for William R. Hodge:

William was a Private in the NY Volunteers, 2nd Regiment, New York Heavy Artillery

Organized at Staten Island, NY, & mustered in by Companies as follows: Companies "C" & "D" Sep 18, Company "B" Aug 23, Companies "A" & "E" Oct 2, Companies "F," "G" & "H" Oct 15, Company "L" Nov 18, Companies "I" & "K" Dec 11 & Company "M" 12 Dec 1861. Eight Companies left State for Washington, DC, 7 Nov 1861. Company "L" left Dec 2, & Companies "I," "K" & "M" 12 Dec 1861. Attached to Military District of Washington, DC, Dec 1861, to May 1862. Sturgis' Command, Military District of Washington, to Jan 1863. Artillery, District of Alexandria, VA, to Feb 1863. Artillery, District of Alexandria, 22nd Army Corps. Dept. of Washington, to Apr 1863. 1st Brigade, DeRussy's Division, 22nd Army Corps, to Apr, 1864. 2nd Brigade, DeRussy's Division, 22nd Army Corps, to May 1864. Tyler's Heavy Artillery Division, 2nd Army Corps, Army of the Potomac, 16-29 May 1864. 1st Brigade, 1st Division, 2nd Army Corps, to Jun 1865. 1st Brigade, DeRussy's Division, 22nd Army Corps, to Sep 1865. (Battery "L" detached Mar 1862, & designated 34th New York Independent Battery Nov 1863. See 34th Battery for history.) SERVICE: Duty in the Defenses of Washington till May, 1864. Pope's Campaign in Northern Virginia Aug 1862. Action at Bull Run Bridge, VA, Aug 27. Battle of Bull Run, VA, Aug 29-30. Ordered to join Army of the Potomac in the field 15 May 1864. Rapidan Campaign May-Jun. Spotsylvania Court House, VA, May 18-21. Harris Farm or Fredericksburg Road May 19. North Anna River May 23-26. On line of the Pamunkey May 26-28. Totopotomoy May 28-31. Cold Harbor Jun 1-12. Assault at Cold Harbor Jun 3. Before Petersburg Jun 16-18. Siege of Petersburg Jun 16, 1864, to Apr 2, 1865. Jerusalem Plank Road Jun 22-23, 1864. Deep Bottom Jul 27-28. Mustered out at Washington, DC, 29 Sep 1865, & honorably discharged from service. Regiment lost during service 10 Officers & 204 Enlisted men killed & mortally wounded & 247 Enlisted men by disease. He was born 1857 in Chemung Twp., Chemung Co., NY<sup>21</sup>, & died 17 Jan 1923 in Chemung Twp., Chemung Co., NY<sup>21,22</sup>.

Cause of Death: Skull was crushed when hit by train.

He married **Anna Elizabeth Ribble**<sup>28,29</sup> 17 Sep 1920 in Sayre, Bradford Co., PA<sup>30</sup>, daughter of Andrew Ribble & Ruth Conway. She was born 14 Jul 1905 in Chrystal, Potter Co., PA<sup>31</sup>, & died 18 Feb 1960 in Elmira, Chemung Co., NY<sup>31</sup>.

Marriage Lic. Application (1902), Informal Family Documents: (1905), Certificate of Death DOB (1906). 1905 was a misprint or misread & that 1906 is correct. This would make Anna 15 when she married. Her mother was widowed laundress at the time. Falsifying age to marry children off in this type of situation was common.
