I am not sure what led Lottie and family to move to Parsons KS unless it was because her daughter worked for the RR. Thomas Handley also was a Fireman for the RR in MO. It is possible that Thomas died working for the railroad in which case he may have died in Parsons KS. Thomas and Lottie had all their children while living in Walker and must have married prior to 1870. The census records say that all the children were born in MO. One of their daughters must have married a Mr. Shean as Lottie has a grandson living with her in the 1895 state census but no one else with the Shean name. The parents of this boy are presumed to have died prior to 1895 as well. Willie Shean was born 1888-89 and is likely the son of Nellie Handley and a Mr. Shean. Another curious thing is the husband of Naomi Handley. She married a Fred Lyscheski (or Lischesk) from WI but I can find no record of anyone with that name in WI.

Served in the US Navy in the civil war. Served as a Landsman on the USS North Carolina, USS Quaker City, and USS Florida. He resided in Philadelphia as early as 1857 and lived with his uncle Henry Phillippi who was his brother's mother. Henry was a carpenter and builder by trade and Nicholas learned the trade from him. When Nicholas enlisted in the Navy he used the name Nathan Phillippi as he was fond of his uncle and indebted to him for learning the trade. His comrades called him Nat Phillippi and he had the letters NP tattooed on the back of his left hand. He left home when he was about 16 or 17 and both of his parents died while he was still young. He lived in Philadelphia, Hatborough Montgomery Co. in 1881, Pleasantville NJ and back to Philadelphia. He owned property at 20 Adams St. in Atlantic Co Pleasantville NJ. He enlisted with the Navy at New York city August 7, 1863 and was discharged August 22 1864 in Brooklyn NY.
